2019 Sangiovese

\$33 bottle \$12 glass

Nanna Vineyards

Texas Sangiovese that is fruit-forward as its Italian name implies. So to say fruit-forward is better.

2018 Cabernet Sauvignon

Vintage 2018

Appellation: Texas High Plains

Moderate weight, good current and black cherry fruit, with judicious tannin and a firm finish with tannins ripe and refined.

2018 Petit Verdot

\$34 bottle \$12 glass

Fruity yet floral, with lush tannins, sweet, and spicy, and the finish is extensive, and balanced in depth with hints of balsamic and spicy aromas.

2018 Barbera

\$38 bottle \$13 glass

Red cherries, raspberries, subtle tannin, chocolate mint, bright acidity, medium-to-light bodied, soft, well-structured tannins

Malbec 2019

\$39 bottle \$14 glass

Texas High Plains

100% Texas Malbec, bold in color and in flavor with plum, spice and cherry characteristics. This medium-to-full-bodied red delivers a punch of rich, lush red and black fruits, with a slight Texas High Plains earthiness.

Baby Red Wine

\$21 bottle \$9 glass

Appellation: Lodi, CA

A combination of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah.

This is a red blend is similar to a light port without the higher alcohol content. This wine is ripe and jammy with explosive flavors of raspberry, plum and cherry for a soft and smooth finish.

2020 Montepulciano Rose'

Appellation: Texas High Plains
